

33rd TROPHY "CITTÀ di MAJANO" - September 6, 2025

RULES

- 1. Sport Association Libertas Majano**, with the sponsorship of **Region Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Municipality of Majano**; the approval of **Provincial and Regional Committee of FIDAL**, with the cooperation of the **Provincial Center Libertas Udine and Regional Center Libertas Friuli-Venezia Giulia, S.O.M.S.** of Majano and with the effective support coming from with the support of the **Municipal Civil Protection team of Majano**, of the **Gruppo Alpini A.N.A.** of Majano, of the Group of the **"Amis di San MARTIN"** of Devecchio di Majano; with the active support of the **FRIULI Foundation**, of the **Municipality of Buja**, of the **Comunità Collinare** and of the local economic and social realities organizes for the day of **Saturday 6 September 2025 the 33rd International Youth Athletics Trophy "Città di Majano"** for **Provincial Representatives FIDAL** and **International Selections** by invitation.
- 2.** The Meeting is reserved to boys and girls athletes of categories "cadetti" & "ragazzi" enrolled by FIDAL or by the respective National Sport Federations, born in **2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013**.
- 3.** Each representative will be allowed to line up only **one athlete per event** and only **one relay team for each age-group**.
- 4.** Each athlete can take part in just one competition plus relay; **athletes of 1,000 m and 2,000 m are not permitted to run relay**.
- 5. ATTEMPTS AT DISPOSAL OF ATHLETES:**
Categories RI/RA (RI=BOYS and RA=GIRLS born on 2012 and 2013) – in contests (**long jump, shot put and vortex**) the available attempts for every athlete are **3**, meanwhile in the high jump the attempts for every athlete are **3** for each step.
Categories CI/CE (CI=BOYS and CE=GIRLS born on 2010 and 2011) – in contest (**long jump, shot put, discus and javelin**) the available attempts for every athlete are **4**, meanwhile in the high jump the attempts for every athlete are **3** for each step.
- 6.** The starting heights and **increments in high jump** competitions will be determined by the technical delegate and will be communicated during the technical meeting.
- 7. TECHNICAL PROGRAM :**
 - Cadetti: 100hs – 80 m – 2,000m - Long jump - High jump – Discus - Weight - Javelin - 4x100.
 - Cadette: 80hs – 80 m – 1,000m - Long jump - High jump – Discus – Weight - Javelin - 4x100.
 - Ragazzi: 60 m – 600 m - Long jump – Weight - 4x100.
 - Ragazze: 60 m - 600 m - High Jump - Vortex - 4x100.
 - Disabled sports: - 50 mp
- 8. INDIVIDUAL PRIZES:** the first 3 of each competition will be awarded a medal. For every of the four competing category the best technical result will be awarded.
- 9. REPRESENTATIVES PRIZES:** each representative will be awarded an **artistic Trophy**.
- 10. CLASSIFICATION:** **Classification** of representatives will be **based on all results**. Points will be assigned for the individual contest and for relay. The winner will gain as many points as the number of representatives, one point less to the athlete second ranked and so on one point to the last one. In the event that some invited teams will not participate in the event, the organizing company reserves the right to request the FIDAL provincial committees to register a second team. In the event of equal score after the last race, the best placings in the individual races and in all categories will be taken into account to define the final ranking of the team. In the event of a further equal score, the position in the final ranking will be determined by adding the FIDAL scores of the individual races and of all categories. In the event of a further equal score, the position in the final ranking will be assigned on equal merit.
- 11. ATHLETES REGISTRATION :** Must be done by **12.00 p.m. of Sunday, August 31st, 2025** by E-mail to informatica.fvg@fidal.it. Changes will be accepted only if communicated by phone, at the tel.nr that we will later defined.
- 12.** For what not regulated by these rules, **the technical rules of FIDAL will own validity**.

- 13.** The Organization denies any liability for missing or irregular registration of the athletes to their own federation and for inexistent federal insurance, for damages and possible accidents that might happen to the athletes or be caused by the athletes.

TECHNICAL RULES COMMUNICATION

1. COMPETITION RULES

All running competitions, “on line” and “hurdles” will be performed by series.
The series with best inscription times will run for last.

2. COMPETITION SHOES

Athletes of categories “ragazzi” and “ragazze” (born on 2012 and 2013) are permitted to **use only normal training shoes**. Spikes, track or “nailable” shoes are strictly forbidden.

3. ATHLETS ENTRANCE IN THE FIELD

Athletes will enter the racing field **15 min. before the start of eachtrack (running) event and 30 min. before the start of eachfield (jumping or throwing) event** and will be accompanied by a race official. The entrance is located nearby the 100m start line. The actual entry time will be determined by race Management.

4. JUMP PROGRESSIONS

Only one starting height, lower than the measure reported in the race regulations, can be selected for each age-group and it will be selected during the technical meeting.

5. RELAYS

For Ragazzi and Ragazze categories (born on 2012 and 2013) changeover within the limits of the change area; however no disqualification for changeover out of the change area.

6. COMPETITION NUMBER NOTICE

For all competitions the number must be on the **chest**

7. AWARDS

- They will be delivered during the event.
- **The first 3 athletes** in each competition must be IMMEDIATELY at disposal of the rewards-attendant and stay in the appropriate place near the speaker’s corner.
- The best overall result of each age-group will receive a **special award**.
- **If a team has more than one athlete per event, additional (non-scoring) athletes will not be awarded.**
